



CAST PIP AMBA PROJECT LICENSE AGREEMENT

This License is entered into between _____ with an office at _____, as licensee ("Licensee"), and CAST, Inc., with an office at 11 Stonewall Court, Woodcliff Lake, NJ 07677 ("Licensor").

1. **Definitions.** In this License, unless the context is otherwise required, the following expressions will have the following meanings:

- (a) "Effective Date" means the commencement date of this License with respect to specific Licensed Materials, as set forth in the Quotation.
- (b) "End User" means a customer of the Licensee who purchases or agrees to purchase the Licensed Products.
- (c) "Intellectual Property Rights" means patent, copyright, design right (whether registered or unregistered), confidential information and any other intellectual property rights or howsoever described or, where the context so admits or requires, and one or more of the foregoing.
- (d) "Licensed Project" will mean the project described in Exhibit C. Derivative or follow on projects or any design work occurring after the Licensed Project has begun production shipments shall not form part of the Licensed Project as herein defined with the exception of bug fixes necessary to remedy errors in Licensed Product. For purposes of this License Agreement, a Licensed Project is a single bitstream (using one or more instances of the Licensed Materials) that may then be used in one or more printed circuit boards.
- (e) "Licensed Materials" means the design data and information relating to Licensor's core specified in the Quotation.
- (f) "Licensed Products" means any integrated circuits using FPGA technology designed, manufactured or marketed by or on behalf of Licensee that incorporate all or any part of the Licensed Materials or were designed using any of the Licensed Materials.
- (g) "Permitted Use" means use by the Licensee of the Licensed Materials in accordance with Section 2 below.
- (h) "Quotation" shall mean a document, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, signed by Licensor containing all relevant commercial details of this License, including but not limited to price, taxes, delivery, effective date and applicable project, as applicable. The Quotation will be deemed incorporated herein upon execution.
- (i) "Purchase Order(s)" means the order form issued by Licensee to CAST, or one of its distributors, specifying the Software, and/or services Licensee orders from CAST, and any Associated Fee(s) based on a corresponding Quotation.
- (j) "Multiuse License" means a license allowing the creation of multiple different bitstreams which incorporate one or more instances of the Licensed Materials, but which are substantially similar in function. Examples of permitted variations are changes to the number and type of peripheral functions, memory sizes and/or contents, and other such variations or customizations as approved by Licensor.
- (k) "Specifications" means the Licensor's published specifications for the Licensed Materials.
- (l) "Volume Limitations" means specific production limits agreed to by Licensee and set forth in the Quotation. If such Limitations exist, they shall be set forth in Exhibit B of this license. CAST shall have the right to request an official statement from Licensee at the end of each year stating the volume of

Licensed Product produced. If the agreed to volume is exceeded, Licensee will be invoiced for additional fees as set forth on the Quotation.

2. **License.** Upon execution of a Purchase Order and payment of the fees set forth in the Quotation, Licensor hereby grants Licensee a nonexclusive, non-transferable license (i) to use the Licensed Materials, solely for Licensee's use in the design, simulation, implementation and manufacture of Licensed Products using FPGA technology arising out of the Licensed Project, and (ii) to make, use, sell or otherwise distribute Licensed Products incorporating the Licensed Materials on a worldwide basis to End Users.
3. **Restrictions on Use.** The Licensed Materials are not designed, intended, or authorized for use in components of systems intended for, or in relation to the operation of, weapons, weapons systems, nuclear installations, means of mass transportation, aviation, life-support computers or equipment (including resuscitation equipment and surgical implants), pollution control, hazardous substances management, or for any other application in which the failure of the Licensed Product could create a situation where personal injury or death may occur. Should Licensee provide any Licensed Product for any such unintended or unauthorized application, Licensee shall indemnify and hold Licensor and its officers, employees, subsidiaries, affiliates, and distributors harmless against all claims, costs, damages, expenses, and reasonable attorney fees arising out of, directly or indirectly, any claim of personal injury, death, or other damages associated with such unintended or unauthorized use, even if such claim alleges that Licensor was negligent regarding the design of the Licensed Materials.
4. **Intellectual Property Rights.** Licensee acknowledges that all Intellectual Property Rights in the Licensed Materials are and will remain the sole property of Licensor. You may not modify or prepare derivative works of the Licensed Materials in whole or in part, except with respect to the purposes of the Licensed Project. Nothing contained in this License will be construed as conferring by implication, estoppel or otherwise upon either party any license or other right except the licenses and rights expressly granted hereunder to a party hereto.
5. **Copying.** This License allows you to copy the Licensed Materials only to the extent necessary for the Licensed Project, and for archival and back-up purposes, provided always that you will at all times and in each instance, reproduce all copyright notices and proprietary legends on each copy in the same manner as such notices and legends appeared on the original. No other copies may be made without the Licensor's prior written consent.
6. **Term; Termination.** This License will commence upon the Effective Date and will remain effective until terminated. You may terminate this License at any time by destroying the Licensed Materials and all copies thereof. This License will terminate immediately without notice from Licensor if you fail to comply with any provision of this License, provided that any payment obligations accruing prior to such termination will remain due and owing. Upon termination of this License, (i) the licenses, rights and covenants granted hereunder and the obligations imposed hereunder will cease, except as otherwise expressly provided for herein, and you will destroy the Licensed Materials, including all copies and all relevant documentation. The provisions of Clauses 1, 5, 8, and 12 will survive the termination of this License.
7. **Governmental Use.** The Licensed Materials are commercial computer software developed exclusively at Licensor's expense. Accordingly, pursuant to the United States Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Section 12.212 and Defense FAR Supplement Section 227.7202, use, duplication and disclosure of the Licensed Materials by or for the United States Government is subject to the restrictions set forth in this License. Manufacturer is Licensor.
8. **Limited Remedy and Disclaimer.** Licensor represents that for a period of 90 days from shipment of the Licensed Materials to Licensee the Licensed Materials will substantially conform to the Specifications. Licensor's sole liability and the Licensee's exclusive remedy with respect of breach of the foregoing limited representation will be limited to error correction or replacement, or if neither is in the Licensor's opinion commercially feasible, termination of this License and refund of any license fee received by the Licensor from the Licensee in respect of the relevant item of Licensed Materials. EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY STATED ABOVE, THE LICENSED MATERIALS LICENSED HEREUNDER ARE PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER

EXPRESSED, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY WARRANTY WITH RESPECT TO NONINFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE. Licensor does not warrant that the functions contained in any of the Licensed Materials will meet Licensee's requirements, or that the operation of the Licensed Materials will be uninterrupted or error free, or that defects in the Licensed Materials will be corrected. Furthermore, Licensor does not warrant or make any representations regarding use or the results of the use of the Licensed Materials in terms of correctness, accuracy, reliability or otherwise.

9. **Infringement.** CAST represents and warrants that the Software does not infringe any copyrights or misappropriate any trade secret of any third party where such intellectual property is registered with an internationally recognized organization. CAST further represents and warrants that the Software is the original work of CAST and its licensors and was developed without access to or knowledge of any third party confidential materials.

9.1 CAST will defend or settle, at its option and expense, any action brought against you alleging copyright infringement or trade secret misappropriation related to the Software. Subject to the provisions of this Section, CAST will pay any costs and damages finally awarded against you that are attributable to the claim, provided that you: (a) notify CAST promptly in writing of the action; (b) provide CAST all reasonable information and assistance to settle or defend the claim; and (c) grant CAST sole authority and control of the defense or settlement of the claim.

9.2. If a copyright infringement or trade secret misappropriation claim is made, CAST may, at its option and expense, either (a) replace or modify the Software so that they become non-infringing, or (b) procure for you the right to continue using the Software. If CAST determines that neither of those alternatives is financially practical or otherwise reasonably available, CAST may require the return of the Software and refund to you any license fee paid, less a reasonable allowance for use.

9.3. CAST has no liability to you for any claim of copyright infringement arising from (a) the combination of the Software with Customer or third party materials, unless it is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction that the Software is the infringing element of such claim; or (b) the modification or translation of the Software or any portion of the Software unless the modification or translation was made or approved in writing by CAST; (c) the use of the Software as part of an infringing process; or (d) any Software provided by CAST' licensors which do not provide such indemnification to CAST' customers.

9.4. Licensee is solely responsible for determining and obtaining any and all lawfully required licenses from third parties, including for the lawful import, export, use, sales, manufacture, distribution or other disposal of Licensee's IC. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Licensee acknowledges that Licensee is aware that implementation or use of the Software, whether to comply with industry specifications or standards or otherwise, may require Licensee to obtain certain licenses.

10. **Limitation of Liability.** THE ENTIRE LIABILITY OF LICENSOR IN RESPECT OF ANY BREACH OF ITS CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS ARISING UNDER THIS LICENSE AND ANY REPRESENTATION, STATEMENT OR TORTIOUS ACT OR OMISSION INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE ARISING UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS LICENSE (TOGETHER AN "EVENT OF DEFAULT") SHALL BE LIMITED TO DAMAGES IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ALL LICENSE FEES PAID BY LICENSEE TO LICENSOR IN THE PRECEDING 12 MONTHS FOR THE APPLICABLE LICENSED MATERIALS. NOTWITHSTANDING THE FOREGOING, LICENSOR WILL NOT BE LIABLE TO LICENSEE IN RESPECT OF ANY EVENT OF DEFAULT FOR LOSS OF DATA, PROFITS, GOODWILL OR ANY TYPE OF SPECIAL, INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS (INCLUDING LOSS OR DAMAGE SUFFERED BY LICENSEE AS A RESULT OF ANY ACTION BROUGHT BY A THIRD PARTY) EVEN IF SUCH LOSS WAS REASONABLY FORESEEABLE OR LICENSOR HAD BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF LICENSEE INCURRING THE SAME. THIS LIMITATION SHALL APPLY NOTWITHSTANDING THE FAILURE OF THE ESSENTIAL PURPOSE OF ANY LIMITED REMEDIES HEREIN. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION WILL CONFER ANY RIGHT OR REMEDY UPON LICENSEE TO WHICH IT WOULD NOT OTHERWISE BE LEGALLY ENTITLED.

11. **Export Restriction.** Licensee agrees that Licensee will not export or re-export the Licensed Materials, reference images or accompanying documentation in any form without the appropriate governmental licenses. Failure to comply with this provision is a material breach of this License.
12. **Third Party Beneficiary.** Licensee understands that portions of the Licensed Materials and related documentation may have been licensed to Licensor from third parties and that such third parties are intended third party beneficiaries of the provisions of this License.
13. **Non-Transferable.** Except as provided in Section 14, Licensee may not provide design data or information including, but not limited to, schematics, hardware description language source code, or netlist files, to a third party without prior written approval from Licensor. Licensee may provide any files necessary to have semiconductor devices manufactured to third parties without prior approval in order to manufacture the Licensed Product.
14. **Non Disclosure.** Except as otherwise expressly permitted in this License, Licensee will hold in confidence the Licensed Materials and all other information received hereunder from Licensor which is marked as Licensor's proprietary information. Without limiting the generality of the preceding sentence, Licensee agrees that the Licensed Materials and documentation furnished hereunder will be treated as proprietary trade secrets of Licensor, and Licensee will not make the Licensed Materials or the documentation available in any form to any person other than to Licensee's employees and contractors subject to restrictions no less stringent than those contained herein, with a need to know and located on Licensee's premises. Licensee hereby represents to Licensor that Licensee maintains a system consistent with semiconductor industry standards to protect Licensee's own confidential business information, including written agreements with Licensee's employees, and that the Licensed Materials and documentation will be protected by such a system to the same extent.
15. **Non-Assignment.** Without Licensor's prior written consent, neither this License nor any interest herein or part hereof will be transferable or assignable by Licensee, by operation of law or otherwise.
16. **Governing Law.** This License shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey, without reference to conflict of laws principles, provided that if the Licensed Materials are acquired in the European Union (the "EU"), this License shall be governed by the laws of the United Kingdom. Nothing in this License will be interpreted or construed so as to limit or exclude the rights or obligations of either party (if any) which it is unlawful to limit or exclude under the relevant national laws and, where applicable, the laws of any Member State of the European Union which implement relevant European Communities Council Directives.
17. **General.**
- (a) Unenforceability. If for any reason a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this License, or portion thereof, to be unenforceable, that provision of the License shall be replaced to the maximum extent permissible so as to effectuate the intent of the parties, and the remainder of this License shall continue in full force and effect.
- (b) Headings. Save as otherwise provided herein, references to clauses, and Schedules are to those contained in this License. Headings are inserted for convenience only and do not affect the construction of this License.
- (c) Construction. Unless the context otherwise requires, words importing the singular include the plural and vice versa, words importing the masculine include the feminine and words importing persons include corporations.
- (d) Waiver. No failure or delay on the part of either party in the exercise of any power, right or privilege hereunder will operate as a waiver thereof, nor will any single or partial exercise of any such power, right or privilege preclude any other or further exercise thereof, or of any other right, power or privilege.
- (e) Entire Agreement. This License and the applicable Quotation contain the entire agreement and understanding between the parties with respect of the subject matter of such Quotation and supersede all prior agreements, understandings and representations. No addition or modification to this License is valid unless made in writing and signed by Licensor and Licensee. The printed terms and conditions of any other Quotation form issued by Licensee will not modify or be a part of this License.
